Using a small paper plate, they colored it the color of their choice and glue mosaic squares to it. The stem and leaves were cut to by the teacher they glued this on to their tulip as well. As they were making their Bumble Bee there was lots of buzzing going on. They were given black and yellow construction circles and they glued these to one another and then glued the eyes and antennas to the bees and the wings as well. By dipping their fingertips into green paint and then onto a page an theme journal they made their fingertip frogs, they did a great job.

For Story Time these stories were read: Poor Puppy, Hands are Not for Hitting, No More Diapers for Ducky, The Crunching Munching Caterpillar, and If You Give a Mouse a Cookie.

On the playground, we practiced our gross motor skills. The children threw the ball to one another, the teacher threw the ball and the children had to catch it, the children kicked the ball, jumped in place and they ran two laps around playground.
