Dear Parents of Gold Door,

This week we discussed the essential question: What shapes do you see around you? To further explore this question we read the story "Shapes All Around Us" which told the students all the different shapes that can be found in a park, at home, and in the street. We also read the story "Kites in Flight" about different cultures using kites to celebrate that come in different colors, shapes, and even animals. While reading the students were introduced to new vocabularies such as materials, nature, decorations, world, and games. They reviewed the letter T practicing writing and sounding out the letter T.

For math the students had their Chapter 3 test and began Chapter 4. They modeled and counted up to 10. We reviewed numbers 1-9 using a tens frame and showing ten with their fingers

For Social Studies, we discussed how we celebrate America and the different holidays throughout the year. We asked why is being a President a big responsibility and explained that two popular Presidents were Abraham Lincoln and George Washington. We also talked about the Native Americans and how they lived in America before someone discovered it.
