Dear Parents,

What a fantastic week! The children amaze me more and more everyday! Their thoughts for their families, while working on their Valentines' Project and on their notes for peers, showed me one more time how beautiful and good they are on the inside! Every child presented their "mailboxes" project and passed out their Valentines. Our Valentines' gathering to share positive notes and goodies :) was wonderful!

During this week we also got to go on the Colgate Truck, the children were engaged at listening to the dentist while she explained how to care for their teeth properly! Some children's teeth were checked, all of the students got a little something from the Colgate group.

This week we covered the long sound of letter i: i, y, igh, ie; vocabulary words such as: imitate, protect, resemble, beautiful, and fancy. We also worked with inflectional endings -ing, and ed, with verb see, sees, saw, rhyming words and recognizing phonemes in words (which we do every week).

For math, we are covering subtracting two digit number problems using different strategies learned, like drawing quick pictures and regrouping as needed.

For Science we are covering animals' behaviors and patterns, parents and their off springs.
