This week we worked on fine and gross motor skills. The children finger-painted and colored freely with crayons and markers. The children continue to practice their fine motor skills by doing spring fun art! They also played with puzzles and are getting better at it. To practice their gross motor skills the children played a game outside in the playground with the teachers by following the leader, marching, and playing Ring-Around-the-Rosies. Parents tips:

The following are some of the milestones your child should be achieving between 1 and 2 years old.

Cognitive (learning, thinking, problem-solving)

- Explores things in different ways, like shaking, banging, throwing
- Finds hidden things easily
- Looks at the right picture or thing when it's named
- Copies gestures
- Starts to use things correctly; for example, drinks from a cup, brushes hair
- Bangs two things together
- Puts things in a container, takes things out of a container
- Lets things go without help
- Pokes with index (pointer) finger
- Follows simple directions like "pick up the toy"
