During this week we discussed the artists that we learned about last week (Van Gogh, Britto and Picasso) and we introduced a technique of painting called Pointillism which was used by George Seurat, the students painted an animal using this technique. The children also experimented with salt art and they learned about the process called hygroscopic, one more thing we discussed this week was symmetry; and the students made a symmetrical butterfly.

For our STEM activities, we explored water and air. The students were encouraged to build a raft that would hold a whole family and that would keep them afloat; on another time they built the roof of a house and their goal was to keep the rain out!
