This week I was out for three days on jury duty but the children had wonderful teachers substituting me and the children still had all the activities planned.

The theme for this week was wild animals. The children made crafts such as; a giraffe which they made by tracing their arm and then decorating it with brown dots made out of construction paper. They also made a lion mask , a flamingo and a snake out of paper plates. The stem activity was building brick challenge. This activity required them to build ramps and ladders where they had marbles move through it. The children had to come up with their own designs as well and test them for movement.
