This week the students reviewed blending long vowel sounds with the silent e. They practiced using these words in a sentence. With their boards, we played a challenge game of different words such as Cone, nine, peek, we, and name. For writing the students wrote two sentences in their journal using the sight words for this week. They practiced finger space, punctuation, and using capital letters at the beginning of a sentence.

For Math the students reviewed adding and subtraction. They were reminded of words such as add, sum, more, equals, plus, and practiced answering problems where the answers are up to 10.

For Science we read Scholastic Magazines each on reviewing different facts, for example, the students learned about what an illustrator does when creating a book, they also read about Abe Lincoln and what his childhood was like, well as what happens when we litter.
