Dear Parents,

This week we discussed the essential question: What ideas can you suggest to protect the environment?. To further explore this topic we read a few stories such as Panda Kindergarten which told the students how a nature reserve for pandas in China takes care of panda cubs. We also read the story Protect the Environment which talked about the different ways we can save energy and help protect the earth. As well as Save Big Blue that gave the students different ways to help protect the ocean. While reading these stories the students were introduced to new vocabulary such as environment, recycle, protect, encourage, and wisely. The students had a change of pace with ten spelling words to practice. They reviewed the long vowel sounds of i,e,o,u, and a. For writing, the students wrote their opinions on different things.

For math, the students reviewed subtraction and addition as well as counting to 20. They also reviewed identifying and counting with tens frames, as well as filling in the missing numbers and which number is larger.

For science, the student read statics magazine about different topics such as helmet safety, sharks, ants, and summer fun in the water.
