This week, we enjoyed Farm Animals.

During Circle Time, the teacher and students sang, danced, and moved to: "Good Morning," "Blow the Balloon", "ABC," "Sticky Bubble Gum," "7 Days of the Week", "Number's Rock," "1,2 Buckle My Shoe," "The Ants are Marching One by One," "This Old Man," and "5 Little Ducks".
