Dear Parents,

This week we discussed the essential question: What kind of bugs do you know about? To further explore this topic, the students read the story I Love Bugs which should include the different types of bugs crawling, flying, and creeping. We also read the story From Caterpillar to Butterfly, which explained a caterpillar's process to become a butterfly. For example, did you know a caterpillar eats their eggshell? The students were so shocked! While reading these stories, the students were introduced to new vocabulary such as process, slender, attaches, curious, and observe. In addition, we reviewed letters m, a,p,s, and t and the short vowel a. we also examined the sight words I, can, the, we, see, a, and like.

In math, we continued with Chapter 4. The children learned to identify a set of ten objects and how to model ten on a tens frame. Then, using red and blue cubes, the children modeled how to show ways of ten. For example, seven blues and three red cubes make ten. The week ended with identifying numbers in counting order and finding the missing numbers. Finally, we took our mid-chapter quiz. Next week we will finish Chapter 4, and our test will be sometime next week.

For science, the student learned the life cycle of a pumpkin. We carved our pumpkin and named him Jack!
