This week our topic was Halloween and letter Ll.

We started the week learning that Halloween is a holiday celebrated on October 31. It is a holiday with a long history and can have different meanings for different people. People all around the world celebrate this day. The main tradition is to dress up in a costume. Some people like scary costumes such as ghosts, witches, or skeletons, but a lot of people dress up in fun costumes like superheroes, movie stars, or cartoon characters.
