We have had a great week learning all about Spring. The children learned that during Spring time all the animals that were hibernating during the Winter, are now waking up and looking for food. They also learned that Spring is a time of year when the weather starts to change. It is a transition season between the winter and summer seasons. The days get longer and nights get shorter, the temperature is milder, and flowers bloom. There is a warm wind in the spring season in the air.

Circle Time- This week we went over the letters, the numbers 1 through 30. We also talked about our Spring theme, and we had the students share stories of what they will be doing this Easter. The children discovered new words with the letter Zz, with this letter we finished the alphabet. Next week we will be recording different letters.
