This week the children had an opportunity to finger paint, sponge paint, dress up puppets, play with Play-Doh, and playing the I Spy game.

Keep promoting independence in your child by letting them feed themselves, show them how to hold the spoon the proper way, and help them if necessary, but always let them do it by themselves. We know it's messier, but in the long run, everyone will benefit, also start introducing the cup, and teach them how to hold it and how to drink from it.

As always we encourage you to work with your child at home helping to develop the skills necessary for their development. In previous letters, we've offered tips and techniques, and we will continue to do so every week.

Help your child become more acquainted with body parts with this activity and song. Place colorful stickers or dots above your eyes, on your forehead, ears, nose, shoulders, knees, and all ten toes. Do the same for your child. Stand up and sing "Head, Shoulders, Knees, and Toes" as you touch the corresponding stickers.

- We need more than a change of clothes, we are promoting independence and your child can get messy. Please check Brightwheel to see what your child needs.
- Keeping nails short is important to your child's safety.
