As we continue our theme of “Compare and Contrast,” this week, children will compare and contrast stories with plots that are alike. They will enjoy discovering and pointing out the differences as well.

During Circle Time, the teacher introduces some rhythm words, such as cat-hat, car, and star. The teacher also introduces 3D shapes, such as spheres, cones, cylinders, and cubes.

For small groups, we reviewed the letters Jj, Ll, and Vv. The children made a ladybug that represents the letter Ll. They had fun searching the class for 3D shapes and then built a castle using the 3D shapes.

We also reviewed the sounds of the letters, by clapping for each sound, they recognized how many syllables there were in their names.

For story time, we read Mary Had a Little Lamb, Maria Had a Little Llama by Angela Dominguez, The Three Little Grasshoppers by Pam Schiller, and The Three Little Pigs.
