Hello, Parents of Kindergarten Students,

I hope you had a wonderful week. My name is Mrs. Melanie and I had the pleasure of working with your children this week as Mrs. Wanda was out.

This week in Language Arts the essential question of the week was “What can happen when we work together?” They came up with lots of ways they could help each other as well as their families. We also worked on our six asking questions: who, what, when, where, why, and how. They learned about different genres of stories and read a fantasy story. We previewed the words poem, idea, and opinion. In phonics, we learned about the long u sound and discussed how the “magic e” turns the short u sound into a long u sound. We worked on pronouns such as I, we, and they. We learned new vocabulary words, grateful, opinion, ragged, marvel, and decide. The students wrote in their journals every day.

In social studies and science this week, the students learned about Earth Day. We talked about different ways we can save our planet, and the students drew pictures of how they would help save the planet. We also learned about endangered animals and how we can protect them in their environments.

This week in math, we learned about sorting and graphing. We learned how items can be sorted and classified into different categories. The students had a lot of fun using manipulatives such as erasers, and plastic tiles to make graphs.
