Dear Parents,

This week, we exposed our little ones to early mathematics! "Counting is fun" was our topic and the children had various opportunities "to count" during our daily activities.. During Circle Time, we sang "The Ants Are Marching One By One", "One, Two, Buckle My Shoe", "5 Little Ducks" and "This Old Man" and we practiced counting with our fingers. The favorite counting activity was when we counted the blocks we stacked to make a tower until they fell down. Well, we couldn't count that far as you know, they loved to make the tower fall! We made also a little game such as counting until 3 to do an action; for example, 1, 2, 3, Run, I'm going to catch you! 1,2,3, slide! We also counted the steps they climb to go on the slide or on the diaper change table.

We had a lot of fun counting backward from 5 to 1 and pretending to be a rocket.

For art, they did one handprint and pasted 1 foam shape on each fingers as we count from 1 to 5. For small group, we played with pegs to enhance their fine motor and eye-hand coordination.

This week, we went to the garden for the first time to observe and water the plants. They could see tomato plants, pepper bells and flowers. They really enjoyed this activity and plan to go back the following weeks; our garden needs to grow and stay beautiful!
