Dear Parents of VPK Classes,

This week our students were learning about Energy and Letter G.

We started with some vocabulary like battery, electricity, energy fuel, gas, heat, and shadows. They learned that heat moves from warm places to cold places, and moves from warm things to cold things and can come from different sources like the light of the sun that heats water and land. The energy of the sun can change the temperature and more light makes things warmer. We also talked about light and shadows. A shadow is made when light is blocked. They also learned that wind is moving air, has energy, and can make things move. We gave them examples of electricity, different kinds of batteries, and their use.

Best of all, Energy for you! People need energy too. We need energy to grow, change and move! We get energy from food. We use it all the time. To play, to rest even to read books, and to blink your eyes!

The children also learned words that start with the letter G, practiced its sound, and wrote words like game, glue, gum, gas, grass, and gorilla.
