Information For Parents:

During their 2 year of life, toddlers learn many important gross motor skills such as walking, running, climbing stairs with one hand held and throwing a ball. They will also learn fine motor skills such as scribbling with a crayon, pointing and putting objects in a container. They will be playing games such as "Ring Around the Rosy" and "The Hokey Pokey" to help them become more coordinated and balanced in their movements.
