

Hello, Parents of Kindergarten,

In math this week, we continued our lesson from last week, on comparing two numbers. The students used the words "greater than", "less than", and "equal to", to draw and show how one number compares to another. They learned how to classify objects, and identify objects in different categories that belong, and do not belong. The students have a good understanding of how to classify and compare objects from various groups. Next week, we will finish up chapter four, and have our chapter test on Tuesday.

Our essential question this week in Language Arts was "What Kind of Bugs Do You Know About?" We talked about all different kinds of bugs and started using scientific language to discover more about them. The vocabulary words of the week were "curious", "observe", "process", and "attaches". We dissected the book "I Love Bugs", highlighting the new bug-related action words like "glide", "flutter", "fly", "curl" and "crawl". In Phonemic Awareness, we went over the m,p,s, short a, and t; furthering our reading skills by learning to break down words one sound at a time. Our word of the week in Kindness 101 was "generosity"; the willingness to help someone. Take the time to speak with your child about what they think generosity means, and the different real-life ways we can show it!

In science this week, we continue to learn about the different types of weather. We also learned that a season is a period of time that lasts for three months per season. The students now know that the four seasons go in a certain order: Winter, Spring, Summer, and Fall. Next week, we will learn about temperature, and how to use a thermometer to check the temperature outside.

Our Halloween Parade is on 10/30/24. If possible, please bring one bag of candies for the homeless children and one bag of non-candy items for our school. Costumes can be worn to school, just be sure to bring an extra change of clothes. No masks or weapons are permitted at school.
