This week's S.T.E.M. Activity was Amusement Park Engineer. The students worked together to build Robby the rollercoaster, Mary the Merry Go Round, and Bob the Bumper Car.

We had a theme for art and story time, which was Transportation. They worked on making a train where every wagon had a letter of their name. This activity allowed them to count how many letters are in their name and also spell their name. They also made a picture of a boat by using different shapes.
