This weeks theme is the Life Cycle of animals and the letter Kk.

The children participated in fun activities. For example: how a butterfly grows and the process for the caterpillar to turn into a beautiful butterfly 

Art and academic enrichment: The children worked on letter Kk this week. We wrote words that start with Kk, drew pictures, spelled words and traced. We then decorated the letter with markers or crayon then cut and glued it to a separate paper. The children had a blast learning about the life cycle of the chick, butterfly, frog and lady bug! We did multiple projects to learn about this. For example, we traced a butterfly on paper then cut it out and divided the butterfly into four sections. We then drew the steps it takes for a caterpillar to blossom into a beautiful butterfly!
