Dear Parents,

This week Red Door is learning about **"My Senses."** Our five senses—sight, sound, smell, taste, and touch—help us understand the world around us, and we learn about each one in fun and interactive ways.

Here's what we did:

- **Sight:** We looked at bright and colorful objects, identified shapes, and played a fun game of "I Spy" to enhance our observation skills.

- **Sound:** The children will listen to different types of sounds, such as musical instruments, animal noises, and everyday sounds. We'll also make our sounds with simple instruments and our voices.

- **Smell:** We smelled a variety of safe scents, and learned to describe them. We'll also play a guessing game to match smells to pictures.

- **Taste:** We did a small taste-testing session with different flavors like sweet, salty, and sour. While eating lunch and snacks.

- **Touch:** The children felt various textures—soft, rough, smooth, and bumpy through hands-on activities with different materials like fabric, sand, and Play-Doh.

We also enjoyed reading with our friend Max a story called "David Smells" that talks about the 5 Senses. Each one was identifying the senses.

How you can help:

- **Reinforce learning at home** by pointing out when your child uses their senses. For example, you can ask, "What do you hear?" when you're outside or "How does this feel?" when touching different objects.

This week was about encouraging curiosity and helping your little ones become more aware of how they interact with the world. We hope this will be an enjoyable and enlightening experience for your child.
