Dear Parents of Kindergarten Students;

I hope everyone had a wonderful week. It was great to see everyone back after the Spring Break!

This week in language arts and reading the children began learning the long sound of the letter Aa. We learned that one of the ways to spell the long sound of the letter Aa is an_e. They learned that the letter e serves as magic since when we use it to spell words like; wake and cake it makes the letter a say its name. We also had 2 new sight words; help and too which the children read, spelled, and wrote sentences with. Next week they will be learning the long sound of the letter li by using the same pattern that they were introduced to this week. In math, we continue learning about measuring. This week they learned how to compare length and height. We used cubes to compare length by using the words longer than and shorter than. They also used cubes to compare height by using the words taller than, shorter than, and same height.

Since this week we had the egg hunt, I took the opportunity to introduce life cycles. They learned about the butterfly, the chick, and the frog life cycle. On Friday we had fun learning about the solar eclipse which was something completely new for them and they will probably experience it next week.

The egg hunt was a success. The children enjoyed finding eggs in the playground which later we counted and everyone took home the same amount of eggs.

Next week I will be sending home the instructions for the science project to turn in the middle of May. It will be something related to animals which is the unit that we are going over in Science.
