We completed theme 10 this week and officially finished our language arts and reading book. Our spelling words consisted of words that compared two or more things. They ended in -er and -est like in smaller and warmest. Our class story was titled, "Days with Frog and Toad." The story was about two friends, one frog, and a toad. It was toads birthday and frog bought him a hat. The hat was unfortunately too big and frog was stumbling everywhere. Frog told him to think big thoughts and his head will get bigger. So he did. Frog snuck into toad's house in the middle of the night, took the hat, and poured hot water on it to shrink it. The hat fit toad and he was so thankful! The story vocabulary was birthday, smaller, giant, and sorry. The children learned how to write a thank-you note. They reviewed the suffix -ly, meaning more of something. We reviewed the sight words with a clap and spell. Our spelling and sight test was on Friday. Next week starts the review of all of our sight words from January till now.

In Math, we completed Chapter 12. This week the students learned how to weigh objects with counting cubes, what capacity means, how to find out which object is heavier or lighter, and how to determine how much a container holds. On Friday we took our chapter test and everyone did a great job. Next week we will learn about the clock.

In Science, we finished our lesson on Plants and Animals' Needs. We reviewed what the difference was between a need and a want. We then made a list of the needs of a plant, then a list of the needs of an animal. Next week our topic is Parts of a Plant.
