Dear Parents of Green and Red Doors,

This week we would love to welcome Miles and Kaiden to the Kids for Kids Academy Family!!!!

What a week full of emotions and feelings! The children learned about the various emotions they feel throughout the day: happy (that is most of the time), sad (just a little when my Mommy or Daddy is leaving), angry (when a friend takes a toy from my hands), tired (after a full morning learning and playing with my friends), excited (dance during music class or Music and Movement, when I go to the playground and running, popping the bubbles, have a turn on the swing, and playing in the sensory box), afraid (sometimes when somebody I don't know comes in the classroom or when I heard the loud garbage truck outside), proud (when my teachers notice that I built a tower with four green blocks or that I am doing a good job helping to clean up), loved (when my friends or my teachers give me a hug).

During Circle Time, we sang songs such as If You're Happy And You Know It and I Have Feelings. We also played with feelings and emotions matching game and "my friends" sensory bin.

Parent tips: Sorting and grouping things together is an important cognitive skill. It teaches your toddler to notice similarities and differences, learn to categorize, and develop early literacy and numeracy skills.

Reminders:

- We need more than a change of clothes, we are promoting independence and your child can get messy. Please check Brightwheel to see what your child needs. Please bring diaper cream.
- Keeping nails short is important to your child's safety.
- MOSQUITO SEASON IS BACK!! If you would like to bring Bugs Spray for your child, you need to fill out a form at the front desk. It needs to be labeled.
- Please send a family picture
- PLEASE DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILDREN TO SCHOOL IF THEY HAVE A RUNNY NOSE OR ARE SICK!
