Dear Parents of Kindergarten Students;

I hope that you had a wonderful week.

This week was a busy and fun week!

The children learned under the topic;" What rules do we follow in different places?" They also learned about the letter li and its sound. We went over words like; iguana, igloo, inch, and ink which have the /l/ sound at the beginning of the word. They also learned to identify the /l/ sound in the middle of words. We went over words like; bit, lit, sit, fit, six, Tim, and tip. The vocabulary words were; rules, cooperate, prank, guard, and responsible. Now that we are learning the short vowel sound of /l/, the children also worked on identifying the short sound of /a/ in the middle of words as well. There was a lot of writing and spelling words during these three days of class. The new sight words were; "to and it" which they spelled, read, and wrote sentences with them.

The science topic this week was: "Pumpkins". We learned the life cycle of the pumpkins, talked about what can we do with pumpkins, and also did an investigation on them. In the investigation, they used cubes to measure the pumpkin and tested each pumpkin to find out if it was going to sink or float. Last, they used tissue paper to decorate their pumpkins.

In math, we finished Chapter 4 and took the test on Thursday. We will begin Chapter 5 next week where they will be introduced to addition.

We also had the Halloween Happening on Wednesday. On that day we worked on Halloween Fun Activities. They made some crafts, did a writing activity, and danced to the Halloween freeze dance. We read 2 stories; " It's Pumpkin Day Mouse and Spokley the Square Pumpkin."

The end of the first grading period finished on Thursday, report cards will be going home next week!
