Hello! This week we learned about Pumpkins. The children saw pictures of pumpkins . We talked about the different sizes they come and that pumpkins are generally round. Some may be flattened or stretched out on the top and bottom. The color is usually orange.

For art, the children colored a small paper plate using an orange crayon and then glued the eyes and nose to their pumpkin and colored in the mouth and added the stem to the top part of their pumpkin. Mosaic pumpkins were also lots of fun. The children decorated a pumpkin using mosaic squares and put the eyes on their pumpkins. Lego stamped pumpkin craft was a blast the children found it amazing how they dipped their Lego piece into paint and onto the pumpkin and the shape of the Lego was seen on the paper.
