We had a fantastic week in our class. The Spring egg hunt was wonderful. The children had tons of fun looking for eggs. Thank you parents for making this day a memorable one.

The topic for this week was Insects. During Circle Time, the children learned about some characteristics of insects, for example: They have three pairs of legs, the body of these small animals is divided into three parts, head, thorax, and abdomen, also that they are laborious. We learned about some insects such as the Firefly, Ant, Dragonfly, Caterpillar, and Grasshopper.

We continue practicing letters and numbers and writing their names on the whiteboard.

During art time, the children traced, colored, and cut out the dragonflies, they also decorated a garden with markers and crayons on construction paper. Next, they glued the previously cut-out dragonflies, and colored the paper plate green. Lastly, they cut the shape of a Grasshopper and added it onto construction paper.

In addition, the children chose ants made of paper and glued them on a colored sheet simulating the grass. They also worked on their journals drawing their favorite insect.
