Dear Parents of Yellow Door,

As we enter the season of Fall, our topic was about leaves, allowing us to review the colors yellow, red, orange, green, and brown.

We had fun at the beginning of the week as we had a “leaves hunt”! We picked up leaves of different sizes and colors and used them for different activities.

Sensory: the children touched dry leaves and fresh leaves to feel the difference in texture. They also observed how some leaves turned from green to orange, red, or yellow to brown.

Circle Time: As we sang the song “All the leaves are falling down, falling down, falling down, all the leaves are falling down, red, yellow, orange, green and brown”, we took some leaves from the bucket and let them fall down or blew them away.

During small group, the children made more projects about leaves: they painted construction paper using a sponge and 4 different colors (green, red, brown, and yellow). They also decorated a pre-cut leaf with red, yellow, orange, and green tissue papers.
