Dear Parents,

We were happy to welcome on Monday our new friend Logan who will turn one next month. We have now a group of 5 children who are doing very well together and who enjoy being in Green Door!

This week, we "took a trip" to Old Mac Donald's Farm! It was a festival of farm animals' songs and sounds. Every day, we could hear "QUACK, CLUCK, COCK-A-DOODLE-DOO, MOO, NEIGH, BAA, SQUEAK, OINK, MEOW, and WOOF". The children enjoyed playing with the farm animal puppets and toys and listening to songs as they learned about animals' names and sounds. They start to repeat the sound of the cow, the sheep (it is so funny to say baaa while sticking out the tongue!), and the pig.

We read a lot of farm animal books and learned that baby animals have a special name: the lamb is the baby sheep, the piglet is the baby pig, the kitten is the baby cat, the puppy is the baby dog, etc...

During Circle Time, we sang "Old Mac Donald Has a Farm", "Mary Had a Little Lamb", "The Animals On The Farm Say", and "Baa Baa Black Sheep".

For Art, the children painted a small carton plate mixing red and white paint and using a brush. The next day, they glued 2 ears, one nose and a tail to make a pig. They made a sheep, making white round marks with the paint using a foam brush, and then glued the head and legs.

During small group activity, they played with puzzles with farm animal themes and they matched the pictures of baby animals with the pictures of their parents (with a little help from the teachers!)

For Music class, they enjoyed listening to Mrs. Michelle's songs such as Underneath the Ocean, Brown Bear, and 5 Red Balloons.
