Dear Parents,

I would like to say thank you for having your child at school by 8:20, I would like to remind you (I sent a message via Brightwheel) that I plan to take the students out by 8:23 in the morning on Fridays so we can tend the garden.

Some skills covered this week during language art were: digraphs -ch, tch, sh, ph, th, wh, and ng (these consonants together make one sound), singular and plural nouns, and abbreviations. We covered the genre of expository text (real events, people, or things, it may contain graphs, maps, diagrams, photos; etc.). We read stories such as "Eagles and Eaglets," "Baby Bears," and "Wild Animal Families." The students were encouraged to look for important details within each text and to find the topic.

The students had their mid-chapter point test during math. We will continue to work with Chapter 3 next week.

I sent home a new small science book for the children to support their knowledge with the new chapter to be introduced "Animals and Plants" Please make sure this book stays in their homework folder so it does not get misplaced. Encourage your child to read a bit every day and to have conversations with you about things learned.

During social studies, we will continue to study tribes in different regions of North America and their beliefs.

During Spanish, we have covered the letters p, m, l, s, and t, shapes, insects, and writing short sentences with the vocabulary learned (yo, soy, puedo, la, el, un).
