In Language Arts and Reading, our spelling words consisted of words that had vowel +r sound /ar/. Some words were arm, dark, start, far, and yarn. Our class story was titled Fireflies For Nathan. Before we read the story we learned about some of our story vocabulary words such as beacon, monarch, and warms. The story was about a boy who went to his grandparent's house.
