Dear Parents,

This week we discussed the essential question: How can you help out at home?. To further explore this topic the students read the story Peter's Chair which is about a little boy sharing his chair and toys with his baby sister. We also read the story Jake and Dale Can Help about two kids helping around the house. We read Helping Out at Home which talked about the different ways to help family members indoors and outdoors. While reading these stories the students were introduced to new vocabulary such as member, organize, accomplish, chores, and contribute. The students were introduced to long vowel (a). They practiced letters and making the sound of long vowel (a). For writing, the students wrote about their favorite books and why they liked them using adjectives.

For Math, the students learned to identify, name, and describe cylinders, cones. They also learned and identified two-three dimensional shapes. To review the students were given clay and asked to create four shapes cylinder, cube, sphere, and cone.

In science, we discussed Push to press against something with force. Pull the act of moving an object towards you. The students were asked to give a different example of push and pull. For an activity, they pushed a car on white banner paper with some paint on the wheels of the car. The students used straws to blow the cars like the wind. Predicting how far the cars will go.

This week the students celebrated Easter with a Spring Egg Hunt on the playground. They really enjoyed hunting for eggs with their friends!
