Dear Parents of Gold Door,

This week we discussed our essential question: What do you see in the sky?. To further explore this topic the students read the story Bringing Down the Moon about a mole who sees the moon and wants to bring it down because it's so beautiful. Another story we read was Up! Up! Up! about a man looking through a telescope and describing everything he sees in the sky. We also read A View From the Moon about the three astronauts who walked on the moon and all the things they saw on the moon. While reading these stories the children were introduced to new vocabulary words such as distance, recognize, space, surface, and challenge. The students also reviewed the letter sounds Vv, Zz, Jj, Yy, and Qq practicing different words that are made with those letters. For writing the students wrote about what they see in the sky and whether it was far or really close.

Math: The students were introduced to Chapter 10 three-dimensional shapes which let the students see the whole shape. We discussed cylinders, spheres, cones, and cubes. They predicted which shape will stack, roll and slide.

For Social Studies this week the students will be learning about different symbols that represent our country United States of America. We discussed the Liberty Bell, the American Flag, the White House, the Washington Monument, Mount Rushmore, and the Lincoln Memorial.
