In order to develop our fine motor skills, we played with some Play-Doh and used various cookie cutters to play and work with our fingers! 

Parents, let’s encourage our little ones to eat with spoons and drinking out of cups all by themselves! It will be messy, however, it will be so beneficial for them in the long run! Let’s work together so that your child can succeed!
