Dear VPK Families,

This week we're beginning a new theme in our classroom, "Safe, Healthy, Helpful Me". In the first week of this theme, we learned about the people in our neighborhood and community who help us stay safe and healthy. We focused on the letters: Hh, Xx, and Yy. They sang different songs for each letter sound and learned words for each of these letters. The children practiced identifying compound words (birdcage, seahorse, fishbowl, mailbox, etc.) They clapped for syllables and copied words from the board. Every morning, they count and identify numbers up to 50 and do the Calendar.

During Art, the children traced, colored, cut, and glued to make a chef's apron, and a horse out of the letter H. In their journals, they drew a picture of what they wanted to be when they grew up. They also traced and colored the letters of the week to make a book.
