We had a fantastic week in Orange Door! This week the students learned about the Amazon Rainforest .”A rainforest is a tall, dense forest that receives lots of rain every year. Rainforests are full of biodiversity, meaning there are lots of different species of plants and animals that live there. There are two types of rainforests: tropical rainforests and temperate rainforests. The Amazon rainforest is the largest tropical rainforest in the world.

Art- The students made snakes using paper plates, Do-A-Dot Markers, scissors, glue, and google eyes. They made chameleons with watercolor paint, plates, scissors, glue, and sticker eyes. They made frogs using crayons, construction paper, glue, and plates. In addition, they made sloths with construction paper and google eyes.

We try to teach them how important being kind to your friends and loved ones is. We reviewed the sounds of the alphabet, and our numbers 1 through 30.
