During this week, the students worked very diligently and happily on their Mother's Day project. They used their creativity to make a masterpiece for Mom. They also practiced using similes while writing a poem for Mom.

This week we covered similes, commas in dates and letters, and inflectional endings -ing and -ed. Some of the stories read were "Let's Dance," "A Spring Birthday," and "Lissy's Friends." We discussed "traditions," and the children were encouraged to find text evidence to find the theme of the stories.

During math, the children continued to work on predicting and measuring the capacity of different containers. We finished with this chapter, we will review the clock, and then we will review all benchmarks covered during the year.
