Dear Parents of Kindergarten Students,

I hope everyone had a wonderful week!

This week the children learned under the topic; "How can things in nature be used to make new things?" They were introduced to the long sound of vowel O. The children learned that one of the ways to spell the long sound of O is by writing o_e. We practiced by writing the words; cone, pole, robe, hose, note and hope. The new sight words for this week were: where and look which they read, spelled and wrote sentences using these words. This week we wrote a recipe together. They wrote a recipe for a trail mix where they listed the ingredients and wrote the steps to be followed when making this recipe. On Friday we put together the recipe for the trail mix.

In math, the children began Lesson 12. In this lesson they are learning about sorting and classifying objects by color, size and shape. They also learned how to graph different color cubes and count how many of each color they had.

In science we continued learning all about animals under the topic; How animals are alike and different? This week we went over how animals move. They learned that each animal has specific body parts like; wings, legs, fins and claws which are necessary for them to move. We also learned about animal coverings and we sorted animals by which have; fur, skin, feathers and scales. We also discussed animal homes and learned about; pond and rainforest.

Next week we will be teaching social studies. Monday the children will discuss all about earth day and the rest of the week as well.
