We had a wonderful week! We finished our Winter theme and the students learned all about the weather. They learned that weather systems consist of the movement of cold and warm air. They learned about rain, clouds, lightning, and thunderstorms. We had the students tell us on the playground each day what the weather was and we recorded the information for them. On Friday we discussed how the weather was for this week.

Art- The students created all sorts of weather crafts this week. They glued cotton balls on a carton plate to make a cloud and colored one yellow to make the sun.
