At Gold Door the children had a great week while participating of different activities.

The theme for the STEM Activities was: Create A Chain Reaction.

We worked in groups using tracks, spinners, different height pendulums to create different chain reactions. As the week progressed the chain reactions became more complex. The children had to figure out how to get different weight balls reach the goal box in all of the chain reactions. It was a fun way to work on problem solving as a group. Along with this activity the children were introduced to the word push: the force that was used to move the ball in these chain reactions.

For arts and crafts we focused on insects. The children reviewed the topic by making a caterpillar, a butterfly, an ant, a ladybug and a plate with the butterfly life cycle.

Gold Door 2 had a little art class where they learned how to draw a cartoon Ladybug and a beehive.

This week we had a field trip. The children went to the Fun Bus.

During music with Mrs. Michelle, the children played the Egg Shakers while practicing their friend's name and talking about where they had been the day before. She also told them a story about a boy named Luigi who loved to eat pasta while they participated in singing some of the story with her. The musical instrument this week was: The guiro-drum: a double percussion instrument.

We continue reviewing letters and numbers as part of our reinforcement activity.
