Our topic this week was all about how plants grow!

We talked about plants growing above and below. A seed goes in the dirt, a root begins to grow down into the dirt, a stem grows out of the dirt and leaves grow on the stem. The children learned that plants need soil, water, and sun to grow nice and healthy. We also talked about eating different parts of plants such as celery (stem), radishes (root), broccoli (flower), tomatoes (fruit) and green peas (seeds), among others.
