This week, our class was introduced to a classic story called “The Gingerbread Man.” The Gingerbread Man is a traditional tale about a magical character, a gingerbread man who comes to life after being tossed into the oven and runs as fast as he can to escape whoever tries to eat him. The children were encouraged to retell the story using character props.

The week's topic for Circle Time is The Gingerbread Man  Sing Along Songs: Gingerbread & Who Took the Cookies?"

Vocabulary: gingerbread, cookies, creative, catch, chase, thankful, patience

Traditional Tales : The Gingerbread Man Books: Smart Cookies Best Friend, The Runaway Cookie Parade Music and Movement:

Playground time: They rode tricycles, ran back and forth, played tag, and jumped up and down. They were throwing and catching the balls.

Summary of our week for a small group: In small groups, the children had an opportunity to use different materials such as Play-Doh, cookie cutters, and rolling pins to create gingerbread men. Additionally, the children were encouraged to use O-shaped cereal to place over the buttons of the gingerbread men while counting and matching the buttons. Lastly, the children decorated a gingerbread man's house using velcro pieces.
