Hello Kindergarten Parents,

Math—In math this week, the students were introduced to comparing numbers. They learned vocabulary such as "greater than," "more than," "less than," and "equal to" or the "same." The students now have a basic understanding of grouping numbers. Next week, we will compare groups to five by counting. We will also close Chapter two and review for the chapter test.

Social Studies—This week, we discussed what a "community" is and who is a part of it, such as schools, police stations, grocery stores, etc. We spoke about how every community has rules and laws and why it is important to follow them. The students had a chance to draw themselves following a rule at school, a rule at home, and a rule in their community, like following the speed limit in their neighborhood. The students were taught that rules help us all get along.

The theme in Language Arts this week was: What can you do? The children wrote about what games they can play and discussed what they are good at by saying, "I can _____. We also read poems and figured out the syllables of some words. The children did this by clapping to each unbroken sound in the word. They also read a story with no words and another one with words where they practiced the sight words; I and can. We also finished reviewing the alphabet this week and concluded the list of vowels and consonants. Next week, we will begin Unit 1, where the children will have another sight word. They will also have spelling words since we will be starting with the letter Mm and the "am" family.
