Dear Parents,

Thank you for allowing your child to participate in an extraordinary fieldtrip! The actors from the Miami Children's Museum amaze us every time they visit. This show was in part a musical, it was fun and absolutely hilarious. They acted out some of the fantastic stories from Dr. Seuss.

We are already heading to our second week in March...! During this week the invitations for your child's ceremony went out; if you did not get yours please let me know so I can hand it to you next week. I will take a picture of it and send it on Brightwheel as well.

This week we worked with the problem, the steps to solve the problem, and the solution of a story. The strategy used while reading was to make predictions, some of the stories read were "The Woodcutter's Gift," and "The Art Project." For grammar and phonics, we covered the variant vowels a, aw, au, augh, al and ough. We also worked with words that sound the same but are written differently and have a different sound (homonyms) and with contractions and possessive nouns.

Comprehension is very important for all subject areas, please make sure your child is reading every day, and ask open-ended questions to check for comprehension. Invite your child to tell you a summary of the story. Have fun reading and discussing a story!

The students will have a math chapter test next week, if your child is struggling with money or telling time (quarter, half past, o'clock) please practice at home. We have a lot to cover yet and some of the coming chapters will go fast as well.

During science, we are learning about fossils, paleontologists, dinosaurs, and findings from the past. Encourage your child to read and discuss the new vocabulary words and the topics learned so far, using the science book provided.

For social studies, we started talking about Citizens and our government. The new vocabulary introduced was citizen, rights, volunteer, recycle, government, and Constitution.
