Dear Parents of Gold Door,

This week we discussed the essential question: How do tools help us to explore? To further explore this we read the story *The Hand Is The Handiest* which told the students that the first tool we use is our hands. We also read the story "Timimoto" about a boy that used many different tools to help him learn. While reading the students were introduced to new vocabulary words such as, Tools, Discover, Fetch, Rumble, and Defeated.

For writing, we discussed that a verb is an action word and the students wrote a sentence using tools that they use in the classroom and an action word.

For math, we continued to review numbers 1-8 and were introduced to numbers 9 and 10. They learned to show and identify using a tens frame. We also took our Chapter 3 Review.

In science, the students learned about the sun and how throughout the day the sun is constantly changing position because the earth is moving. We went outside and looked at the direction the sun is in the morning, evening, and afternoon.

This week the students had an indoor field trip with the staff from the Children Museum called out of the box! They really enjoyed the show!
