Dear Parents,

During this week we covered skills such as Diphthongs (oy, oi), syllables with ending (/al/, /el/), pronouns I, Me, We, Us and Capitalization of pronoun I. I introduced "idioms." The students learn about "the point of view" of a character, we reviewed the characteristics of a fiction story (characters and events are made up, it has a beginning, middle and ending and there is usually a problem at the beginning and a solution at the end). We practiced how to find the point of view and the theme in a story.

We are almost done with Chapter 8 in Math, please make sure that your child is up to date with those lessons if your child has been out recently; each child has a math packet that covers the whole chapter. We will finish and review the chapter next week.

We started our Science review and we will finish it on Monday, ask your child to read his/her Physical Science small book "Energy" and discuss things like "What is energy?" "How do living things use energy?" "How do we get energy?" "What is solar energy?" "What are some sources of heat?" etc.

The children have been busy doing projects and singing songs when ever we have some free time!
