This week the children learned under the theme; What ideas can you suggest to protect the environment. They reviewed all of the long vowel sounds, and each of their spelling words this week contained a long vowel sound. To learn and practice this ,they had words like; lake, rake, bone, and slime. The sight words were; who, and help which they read, spelled, and wrote sentences using those words. We also continued to review the pronouns where they had to substitute the noun part of a sentence with a pronoun. They reviewed pronouns like; we, they, she, he, and it.

In science, we continued learning about animals. This week the students learned about how to protect our environment. They learned about the three R rule; reduce, reuse, and recycle. They came up with different ideas about how they can recycle at home and save energy.

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In math, we reviewed adding parts to whole. We reviewed 1-10 counters and ten frames. We also reviewed addition and subtraction sentences. We wrote problems on the board and worked them out together.
