The theme of this week was Easter. During our Circle Time we sang, danced and moved all our body at the rhythm of Good Morning, ABC, Counting Rock, 7 Days of the Week, Head, Shoulder, Knees, and Toes, If You're Happy, The Wheels of the Bus;, Sticky Bubble Gum, Elevator, Bingo, Old McDonald, Action Song, Listen & Move, Freeze Song, and Baby Shark.

During Story Time, we read, Hands are Not for Hitting, Llama Llama Misses Mama, Ducky Goes Potty, The Color Blue, Llama Llama Red Pajama, and, The Very Hungry Caterpillar.

During art, the children put their hands into purple and white paint and then onto pink construction paper and then added the eyes to make their bunny. The kids used the do.a.dot markers to decorate their egg. The students decorated half of a paper plate with green tissue paper and then added eyes and ears to their bunny. The children colored an Easter egg, and then added strips of colored construction paper and glued mosaic square to it. For gross motor skills, the children hopped like a bunny, threw balls to one another, kicked the balls, hopped in place and, they love to go up the slide stairs and down the slide in the playground.
