 Dear Parents,

During this week we talked about how animals help each other, we read stories such as "Animals Working Together," "A Team of Fish," and "Animal Teams."

I am focusing on comprehension skills such as visualizing what they hear, paying attention to the sequence of events and looking for text evidence that support the topic or main idea. We worked with the long sound of letter e (e, ee, ea, ie) and with verbs has and have.

We finished a chapter about skip counting in math, this skill seemed a bit confusing for a few children; yet, after practicing and practicing most of the students understood. We are moving on to using strategies to solve two-digit addition problems.

During Science, we reviewed living and non-living things, the offspring of some animals and the growth of a plant. We replanted our black beans at the garden after they germinated in a ziploc bag. We wrote observations about this growth.

For Social Studies, we continue to learn about economics, we read and discuss how to make choices and what needs /wants are.
